

CALL FOR TENDERS

MANAGEMENT OF WHEAT VARIETY CLASSIFICATION OPERATIONS



The Grains Research and Development Corporation (GRDC) is a statutory corporation with a mandate to plan, invest and oversee research and development to the benefit of its joint stakeholders, the Australian Government and the Australian grain growers.

Wheat variety classification is the categorisation of wheat varieties into grades based on processing and end product quality.

Traditionally wheat classification has been conducted by AWB International on behalf of the grains industry; however, with the change in wheat marketing legislation, new arrangements are required. In line with the recommendations of the Wheat Industry Expert Group, the GRDC has agreed to manage wheat variety classification.

The GRDC is seeking tender applications from interested parties with the capability, proven track record and relevant links to provide the operational activities of wheat variety classification.
