



**PERMIT TO ALLOW MINOR USE OF AN AGVET CHEMICAL PRODUCT  
FOR THE CONTROL OF DIAMONDBACK MOTH IN CANOLA  
ON THE LOWER EYRE PENINSULAR - SOUTH AUSTRALIA**

**PERMIT NUMBER - PER12297**

This permit is issued to the Permit Holder in response to an application granted by the APVMA under section 112 of the Agvet Codes of the jurisdictions set out below. This permit allows a person, as stipulated below, to use the product in the manner specified in this permit in the designated jurisdictions. This permit also allows any person to claim that the product can be used in the manner specified in this permit.

## CONDITIONS OF USE

### Product to be used:

AFFIRM INSECTICIDE

Containing: 17 g/L EMAMECTIN as the only active constituent.

### Directions for Use:

Crop	Pest	Maximum Rate
Canola (Lower Eyre Pensinsula only)	Diamond Back Moth Larvae ( <i>Plutella xylostella</i> )	2 applications at 150 mL/ha OR 1 application at 300 mL/ha

### Critical Use Comments

Apply by ground or aerial application.

Ground Application: Apply in 80L spray/ha

Aerial Application: Apply in 20L spray/ha

Apply from cabbage to early flowering stage, when insects reach threshold levels.

Add a non-ionic surfactant at a rate of 100mL/100L.

### Spray Drift Restraints

- **DO NOT** apply when wind speed is less than 3 or more than 20 kilometres per hour as measured at the application site.
- **DO NOT** apply during surface temperature inversion conditions at the application site.

### Withholding Period

Harvest<sup>1</sup>: DO NOT harvest for 7 weeks after application.

Grazing: DO NOT graze or cut for stock food for 7 weeks after application.

### Jurisdiction

SA, Lower Eyre Pensinsula only

### Supply of Treated Produce

**DO NOT** supply oilseed or stockfeed treated under this permit without providing the buyer with a vendor declaration stating that the products have been treated in accordance with all registered label and approved instructions contained within permit PER12297 including that rates did not exceed the maximum approved rates and the withholding period for emamectin has been observed as set out on permit PER12297.

The vendor declaration must also detail the rate and the dates of application and harvest, or cutting (windrowing) for the harvest of grain or seeds. A form similar to the Grain Trade Australia's Grain Vendor declaration (<http://www.graintrade.org.au/contracts>) is acceptable under the condition that it contains all the above stated details.

<sup>1</sup> The harvest withholding period is the time that must elapse between application of a pesticide and harvest, or cutting (windrowing) for the harvest of grain or seeds.

### Application Records

Users of this product **MUST make an accurate written record** of the details of each spray application within 24 hours following application and **KEEP** this record for a minimum of 2 years.

### Precautions and Protection of Bees

Dangerous to bees; **DO NOT** apply to crops in flower without surveying the local area to determine presence of managed apiaries. **DO NOT** apply to crops until any managed apiaries have been removed to a safe distance.

No re-entry period for bees has been established in relation to this use pattern. Users must advise apiarists that crops have been treated with emamectin prior to allowing entry into treated areas.

The permit holder must contact all registered beekeepers operating in the Lower Eyre Peninsula and advise them of the risks associated with placing hives on canola this season.

### Additional Conditions

THIS PERMIT provides for the use of a product in a manner other than specified on the approved label of the product. Unless otherwise stated in this permit, the use of the product must be in accordance with instructions on its label.

PERSONS who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the details and conditions of this permit.
